This notice is about the COVID-19 vaccination.

You can receive the vaccine upon your request this time.

Please read this notice and the attached "A4 size instructions" thoroughly.

Please make an appointment if you would like to receive the vaccine.

We are sending this notice to those 65 years of age and older (born before April 1, 1957).

• The notice will be sent to those 75 years of age and older (mail on April 23) and then to those 65 to 74 (mail on May 6) (years of age as of March 31, 2022). We will announce to those under 64 years of age later.

It might remain hard to make an appointment for the vaccine because the quantity provided by the government is currently limited.


The government will have enough supply to be able to vaccinate all those who would like to receive. Thank you for your patience.

(Do not cut off the vaccination ticket and vaccination certificate. Please bring them as they are.)

2 Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire

(2 sets of 2-page duplicated sheets are enclosed. Use one set per dose. Please fill out the section in the bold frame and bring it to the site on the appointment date.)

(such as driver's license, health insurance card, or other official certificate issued by government offices)

^{*}You might be able to receive the vaccine at medical or nursing care facilities if you have been hospitalized. Please consult at the medical or nursing care facilities.
